STATEMENT ON RoHS (3) REGULATIONS

The EuroTech Group plc, as a supplier of made to order Printed Circuit Boards (PCB), through both its manufacturing facilities in the UK and through its accredited offshore subcontract PCB manufacturers, is committed to providing products which are safe with respect to the environment and human health.

In that regard, The EuroTech Group plc takes note of Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 8, 2011 and Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of March 31, 2015 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (“RoHS Directive”) and its subsequent amendments, which prohibits the following substances in amounts above specified thresholds in electrical and electronic equipment.

- Cadmium(Cd): 0.01%
- Mercury: 0.1%
- Lead(Pb) : 0.1%
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) : 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB): 0.1 %;
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE): 0.1 %
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0.1%
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): 0.1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0.1%

The EuroTech Group plc, have verified with all its raw material and subcontract PCB manufacturers that all materials and finishes supplied to it are in compliance with these RoHS regulations and confirms:-

“To the best of our knowledge, these products do not contain any of the listed compounds in a concentration exceeding the thresholds of 0.1% by weight in the homogeneous material for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBBs, PBDEs, DEHPs, BBPs, DBPs, DIBPs and of 0.01% by weight in the homogeneous materials for cadmium”.
